Note: All payments must be made through FACTS tuition management system. Both credit cards and EFTs (cash) are accepted for payments through the FACTS system.

These rates are only valid through August 1, 2026. Students who enroll after August 1, 2026, are subject to alternate payment plans.

- Annual payments are due June 1, 2026.
- Bi-Annual payments are due June 1, 2026 and December 1, 2026.
- Quarterly payment plans are due June 1, 2026; September 1, 2026; December 1, 2026; and March 1, 2027.
- Monthly payments are due beginning June 1, 2026 and ending May 1, 2027.

ADDITIONAL FEES & DISCOUNTS

APPLICATION FEE • New students only

New students will be charged a one-time, non-refundable application fee of \$75 per student.

RE-ENROLLMENT & FACILITY FEE • Current students only

Early re-enrollment rate until February 15: \$150 per student (non-refundable)

Reduced re-enrollment rate between February 16-28: \$200 per student (non-refundable)

Regular re-enrollment rate beginning March 1: \$250 per student (non-refundable)

REGISTRATION & FACILITY FEE • New students

\$250 per student (non-refundable)

LATE FEES / INSUFFICIENT FUNDS / RETURNED PAYMENT FEE • \$50 per item

Fee payments are due by the 1st of each month. There is a \$50 fee charged for any returned checks or statement of insufficient funds through the FACTS system.

TEXTBOOKS & CURRICULA COSTS • Varies by class

Textbooks and curricula run approximately \$100-\$250 per class. Used books are sometimes available for purchase. Families are responsible for acquiring their own books and curricula.

OPTIONAL CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITY FEES • Varies by activity

Participation in co-curricular activities, athletics, and clubs may require additional fees to cover supplies, uniforms, coaching stipends, chaperones, etc. Costs vary by program.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

NON-REFUNDABLE FEES

Registration/Re-enrollment and application fees are required by each family for each school year and are neither refundable nor transferable. Acceptance of the registration fee does not guarantee enrollment.

RESPONSIBILITY FOR PAYMENT OF FEES

Due to our commitment to fully pay our educators for the entire school year, a full-year commitment to the co-op is necessary. Parent(s) or legal guardian(s) are required to sign a Financial Agreement for the school year and are fully responsible for payment of all fees according to the established payment schedules. Parents are responsible for payment of class fees, registration fees, books, and other fees for each student.

PAYMENT SCHEDULES

Failure to maintain timely payments per the financial agreement with Coastal Community School and Coastal Community Co-op may result in the student being denied admission to class. Students may not be admitted to class for the second semester or re-enrolled for the following school year while there is a delinquent amount outstanding. Failure to pay past due amounts after repeated requests may result in an account being turned over to an outside collection agency. This does not reduce, eliminate, or waive any obligation to pay amounts owed to Coastal Community School or Coastal Community Co-op. Additionally, if fees are not paid, a late fee will be applied. No extracurricular activities will be allowed if fees are not paid.

WITHDRAWAL

The operating cost of the co-op depends on the commitment each family makes to attend Coastal Community Co-op. You will be responsible for the balance of the yearly tuition and all fees. All fees and tuition are non-refundable and non-transferable at any time. Before any student withdraws, parents must complete a withdrawal form, as well as a pre-withdrawal meeting with administration. If a family decides to withdraw from Coastal Community Co-op, they must notify the co-op no later than July 1. If a family withdraws any time after July 1, the family is committed for the entire tuition and fees, regardless of circumstances (i.e. any personal decision or a disciplinary action resulting in expulsion).

DISMISSAL

If a student is dismissed by the administration for any reason, fees for the remainder of the year, as well as any outstanding fees, are due in full. Registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable at any time.

CONDITION OF ATTENDANCE

On the first day of school, a child may not be admitted to class unless the registration fee, and at least one-tenth of the annual fees have been paid. Students may be denied admission to class when an account has a delayed payment of 60 days or more.

VACATION, HOLIDAYS, ILLNESSES, HURRICANE DAYS

Class and program fee credits or refunds are not available for vacations, holidays, illness, or hurricane days.

GRIEVANCES
